

## 2020 Updates

In 2020, Michigan State University enhanced the Counseling & Mental Health Services reimbursement program by adding eligible services and a broader base of provider types. Many of these changes were a result of feedback received from MSU survivors.

In addition to outpatient counseling and mental health services, MSU expanded eligible services to include:

- Pharmacy services, oral & nasal medications (April 2020);
- Inpatient hospitalization, with a mental health diagnosis (April 2020);
- Ketamine infusion therapy (December 2020);
- Residential mental health treatment (December 2020).

Provider types were added:

- Licensed Professional Counselor Intern (LPC Intern);
- Physician Assistant (PA) with mental health specialty;
- Limited Licensed Psychologist (LLP).
