

Inpatient Services - Survivors

Eligible reimbursement must be for out-of-pocket expenses related to inpatient hospitalization with a mental health diagnosis. All services must be provided by a licensed mental health professional, primary care physician, or with written approval from a licensed mental health professional or primary care physician for medical procedures for related physical injuries, at a licensed inpatient facility.

Ineligible expenses include, but are not limited to:

- Partial hospitalization that is **not** related to the treatment of mental health, or for medical procedures for related physical injuries that are **not** approved by a licensed mental health professional or primary care physician in writing;
- Hospitalization for conditions other than mental health treatment, or for medical procedures for related physical injuries that are not approved by a licensed mental health professional or primary care physician in writing.

Requests previously submitted to and reimbursed by the former fund administrator are not eligible for reimbursement.

Services that are not expressly listed as ineligible may be submitted for consideration and are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. If you are not certain if the service you are receiving--or are interested in receiving--is eligible, please contact JND Legal Administration.

99231 - 99233	Subsequent hospital care evaluation and management
99251 - 99255	Initial inpatient consultation, as part of inpatient behavioral health services

Survivors with insurance will supply a copy of Explanation of Benefits (EOB) from all insurance companies that covered outpatient services, along with a completed reimbursement form.

Survivors who do not have insurance will supply a paid invoice or superbill from the mental health provider, along with a completed reimbursement form.
