

## 2025 Updates

In 2025, Michigan State University enhanced the Counseling & Mental Health Services reimbursement program by providing clarification on what services are eligible for reimbursement for the spouses and/or parent/legal guardians of MSU survivors. These changes were a result of feedback received from survivors.

MSU provided clarification on eligible services for spouses and/or parents/legal guardians of survivors:

- Spouses and parents/legal guardians of survivors may submit requests for reimbursement for individual or group therapy.
  - Spouses and/or parents/legal guardians with insurance will supply a copy of the Explanation of Benefits (EOB) from all insurance companies that covered outpatient services, along with a completed Reimbursement Form.
  - Spouses and/or parents/legal guardians who do not have insurance will supply a paid invoice or superbill from the mental health provider or primary care physician, along with a completed Reimbursement Form.
