

Residential Treatment Services - Survivors

Eligible reimbursement must be for out-of-pocket expenses related to residential treatment with a mental health diagnosis. All services must be provided by a licensed mental health professional, or with written approval from a licensed mental health professional or primary care physician for medical procedures for related physical injuries, at a licensed residential facility.

Ineligible expenses include, but are not limited to:

- Partial hospitalization that is **not** related to the treatment of mental health, or for medical procedures for related physical injuries that are **not** approved by a licensed mental health professional or primary care physician in writing;
- Hospitalization for conditions **other than** mental health treatment, or for medical procedures for related physical injuries that are **not** approved by a licensed mental health professional or primary care physician in writing.

Requests previously submitted to and reimbursed by the former fund administrator are not eligible for reimbursement.

Eligible Residential Treatment for Mental Health

<u>Service Code</u>	<u>Description</u>
99221 - 99223	New or established behavioral health patient, initial residential care
99231 - 99233	Subsequent residential care evaluation and management
99251 - 99255	Initial residential consultation, as part of residential behavioral health services

Eligible Residential Facility for Mental Health

<u>Revenue Code</u>	<u>Description</u>
1001	Residential Treatment - Psychiatric

Survivors with insurance will supply a copy of Explanation of Benefits (EOB) from all insurance companies that covered residential treatment services, along with a completed reimbursement form.

Survivors who do not have insurance will supply a paid invoice or superbill from the mental health provider, along with a completed reimbursement form.
